The attached inventories are effective as of February 1, 2015 and can be obtained utilizing a requisition request via eCAPS.

The first-aid kit identified as Commodity Code 345-32-00-003766 (Exhibit "A" attached) is approved for use in County facilities with minor trauma, office-type settings.

The first-aid kit identified as Commodity Code 345-32-00-003767 (Exhibit "B" attached) is for use by County facilities with moderate trauma, building craft-type settings.

The appropriate approval (Exhibit "A" or Exhibit "B") should be kept with the first aid kit in the event Cal/OSHA (California Occupational Safety and Health Administration) asks for proof that the contents were approved by a physician.
